


A ROADTRIP PLAN ESPECIALLY FOR PATTI JONES



SOUTH MILWAUKEE, WI TO DOOR COUNTY AND BACK



DAY 1 HIGHLIGHTS

- 1. Leave from home Saturday Morning
 - Pack a picnic for dinner grills available at park
 - I-94 to I-43 North to WI-57 North
- 2. Sturgeon Bay
 - Early Lunch Bluefront Café
 - Walking trail at Bayview Park before or after lunch
- 3. Bay Shore/County G Scenic Drive
 - Michigan Street, Left on N 3rd
 - Continue on Bay Shore Drive for about ½ hour
- 4. Egg Harbor
 - Get out and stretch your legs , check out the town & harbor
- 5. Check in at Open Hearth Lodge (after 3pm)
- 6. Peninsula State Park (before &/or after check-in)
 - Purchase State Park sticker, State Trail pass, map
 - Scenic drive around Shore Drive check out viewpoints
 - Picnic near Nicolet Bay
 - Northern Sky Theater showing at 8pm




Parking: Street parking, Parking lot across the street

- 1. Leave Open Hearth Lodge in the morning
 - Pack swimming suits, small backpack with water bottles
 - Pack picnic lunch
- 2. Breakfast at Door County Bakery
 - Quaint place with breads, pastries & cappuccino
- 3. Edge of Park Rentals
 - Rent bicycles for Peninsula State Park bike trails
- 4. Peninsula State Park
 - Ride bicycle trails (9.6 miles total)
 - Visit the Lighthouse
 - Swim at Nicolet Bay
 - Visti the Nature Center
 - Return bicycles
 - Hike Eagle Trail (2-mile loop) rated a 'must do', somewhat strenuous
 - Note: Eagle Tower no longer exists
- 5. Dinner! Fred & Fuzzy's Waterfront Bar & Grill
 - Tiki bar on the beach, fun for the whole family
- 6. Skyway Drive-In Theater or relax at the Lodge
 - Double feature, starts at dusk


DAY 3 HIGHLIGHTS

 - Pack small backpack with water bottles
- Breakfast at the Lodge
- Drive up to Ellison Bluff State Natural Area
 - a densely wooded two-tiered rock terrace with spectacular views
- See more of Peninsula State Park
 - Catch up with any left overs from Day 2
- Lunch Wild Tomato Wood-fired Pizza and Grille
 - 10677 N Bay Shore Dr, Sister Bay
- 6. Pirates Cove Adventure Park - Sister Bay
- 7. Dinner! - Old Post Office Restaurant Fish Boil
 - A Fish Boil is a must do in Door County!
 - Make reservations as soon as you can!
- 8. Wilson's Ice Cream Parlor
 - Vintage soda fountain serving ice cream, housebrewed root beer

- 1. Check out of Open Hearth Lodge in the morning
- 2. Breakfast at Al Johnson's
 - Goats graze the sod roof atop this casual log-cabin eatery serving traditional Swedish fare
- 3. Cana Island Lighthouse opens 10am
 - Walk to an island, travel back in time, and tour the lighthouse for fantastic views!
- 4. Cave Point County Park
 - Picnic area, short hike, limestone cliffs, swimming
 - Be sure to walk down the trail to see the rock garden!
- 5. Crescent Beach Boardwalk Algoma
 - Beach trail & swimming
- 6. Neshota Park Two Rivers
 - Trails in a picturesque river setting
- 7. Back to I-43 South to home
